Spring Cleanup & Food Drive Saturday, May 5, 2018

Cleanup -- In conjunction with the city of Richmond and Chesterfield County, the Greater Oxford Civic Association (OCA) will again conduct a Spring Cleanup for the Oxford community. The cleanup will take place on Saturday, May 5th, beginning at 8 a.m. To participate, place material at the curbside no later than 7:30 a.m., May 5th (no exceptions!). The OCA crews will pick up just about anything, including appliances, general trash and yard debris (**leaves must be bagged and branches must be bundled in lengths no greater than 4 feet**). Hazardous materials, building lumber scraps, large trees and stumps will not be picked up, as they may endanger the safety of our volunteers. Please note that the appliance trucks may make their pickup during the week after the Spring Cleanup, depending upon truck availability.

If you need assistance helping move items to your curb, contact Wayne Gauthier at 804-377-3091 before Monday, April 30th to schedule a 30 minute or less window to have the items removed from your home. This service is free for OCA members or only \$15.00 for non-members (difference covers one year membership dues in the OCA).

If you wish to volunteer for the cleanup day activities, contact Wayne at 804-377-3091. Please take advantage of this opportunity to remove any yard debris or other junk in or around your home. Let's keep Oxford clean!

Food Drive -- The OCA is collecting canned and boxed food for the Central Virginia Food Bank. Residents should place their bags of donated food by their mailboxes by 8:00 a.m. on May 5th. The food drive is a great way for the Oxford community to give to area folks who are less fortunate. Food banks typically have short supplies this time of year. Any donations will be appreciated.
